[Hebrews 1:3-9](#)

### PRAY & CONNECT

### GROW

#### Read [Hebrews 1:3-9](#)- "Jesus Christ is God's Son"

- How is Jesus greater than the angels? Greater than the High Priest? What does that mean to you?

#### Read [Hebrews 2:1-4](#) - "A Warning against Drifting Away"

- Have you ever started to drift away from God? Have you had seasons of your life when you wondered if it was worth it to keep believing Jesus? What does the Bible say about it?

#### Read [Hebrews 2:10](#) - "Jesus, the Man"

- How has Jesus' suffering saved us? Can you relate to the importance of being God's children and how important we are to him?

#### Read [Colossians 1:15](#)- "Christ is Supreme"

- Do you see Jesus as greater than? How can we remember that it's just Jesus. Period. That he's the one who can save us? How does [John 3:16](#) remind us of the power of Jesus?

Take time to pray for Ava, the girl who needs a new heart. Also pray for anyone you know who is suffering and needs assurance that our God is bigger and above all! Thank Jesus for his sacrifice and his love.
