Description

Responsibilities Included:

- Assist with weekly production responsibilities, including the shooting and editing of material for worship services, ministry classes, and online distribution.
- Assist in the daily management of equipment, digital assets, and scheduling of production responsibilities.
- Over the term of the internship, participant will be responsible for producing one "thesis" project, in conjunction with a ministry within Lutheran Church of Hope. They will be responsible for "client" relationships, writing, shooting, editing, and other duties necessary to complete the project, under the supervision of Studio staff.

Qualifications

- Applicant must be familiar in multiple disciplines of video/film production, with emphasis on narrative story construction and documentary process (e.g. journalism). Preferred candidates will be familiar with camera operation, non-linear editing, basic interview lighting, and sound recording.
- Applicants will be asked to provide a "reel" or other portfolio of completed projects they have worked on, showing contributions to a team-led final product, or solo pieces—for school credit, or extracurricular.
- Ability to participate within a multi-disciplinary team as well as acting autonomously as appropriate.
- Motivated, organized, and possess good communication skills.
- Preferred candidates should have a core understanding of scripture, and how our lives today are led by the Gospels, in particular.
