- Attend REVIVE WDM weekly
- Attend weekly weekend worship at Hope West Des Moines
 - Interns are learning about Hope's mission, vision, theological and practical approaches to ministry, etc. Attending weekly worship gives the intern the best ability to understand Hope's ministry and vision.
 - To be in the know about what's happening and how/who to collaborate with each ministry
 - o Theological specifics of Lutheran Church of Hope & the ELCA
- Be able to sign onto Hope Ministry Leader Covenants
- Carry self as a leader, recognizing that people look up to you

Responsibilities

- Assist with weekly responsibilities in preparation for and during REVIVE weekly worship
- Assist with the coordination and execution of REVIVE ministry events
- Attend Hope's Intern Gatherings for professional ministry development
- Intern Special Project
- Events coordination and promotion under the guidance and direction of REVIVE Young Adult Minister. Encourage positive internal and external communication of Hope events and classes
- Presence & participation at WDM worship services and primary events

- Prior experience with REVIVE or a Hope ministry is preferred
- Ability to speak confidently in public
- Able to manage complex tasks with lots of details
- · Preferred candidates are college or grad school students
- · Motivated, organized, and possess good communication skills
- Detail-oriented and self-motivated, with good multitasking abilities
- Strives to live a Christ-centered life, stemming from a personal relationship with Jesus
- Works well with others, maintaining positive and effective relationships with church staff and ministries, volunteers, church members, and guests.
- Demonstrates honesty and integrity, respects confidentiality and Hope policies
- Commitment to reflect in the best light possible Lutheran Church of Hope, Hope staff, and Hope mission, vision, and values
