



Student Ministry Worship Intern (Grimes)

The Student Ministry Worship Intern at Hope Grimes is a part-time unpaid opportunity to equip and provide high school students with experience to fulfill a calling to worship leading. The Student Ministry Worship Intern is responsible for partnering with and supporting the Worship Leader in planning, leading rehearsal, and executing effective worship services for Powerlife (middle school) and Ignition (high school). This internship lasts one Student Ministry year (August – May).

Additionally, this internship requires musical ability, a servant heart for people, intuitive leadership skills, organization, adaptability, problem solving, a collaborative mindset, and most importantly, a servant heart for Jesus Christ. The Student Ministry Worship Intern follows and upholds the mission, vision, and values of Lutheran Church of Hope.

Preferred Experience

- 2+ years in music – singing, playing an instrument
- 1+ years team leadership experience – school, clubs, sports, work
- Ability to lead solo from acoustic guitar

Supplemental Experience**

- Ability to lead solo from piano
- Ability to run a rehearsal with a full band
- Experience with Ableton Live, ProPresenter, and Planning Center

Primary Responsibilities

- Support the Worship Leader in all Student Ministry worship services including, but not limited to:
 - PowerLife & Ignition services (Wednesday nights)
 - Student Ministry Special Events (Worship nights, retreat worship, Christmas party)
- Coordinate and lead all worship components of Student Ministry
 - Be prepared and on time to facilitate and lead band rehearsals
- Encourage the musical and spiritual development of volunteers
 - Walk alongside, pray for, and support volunteers on the team
- Engage with students and volunteers
- Dress appropriately for the job and services
- Other duties as assigned by Worship Leader

Additional Growth Opportunities

- Serve and lead on weekend worship team (Saturday and/or Sunday services)
 - Tuesday night availability required to lead on Sundays
- Partner with Worship Leader for larger campus events (including holidays, worship nights, and VBS)
