A Letter from Your Pastors

Yet the dream was not only for a church, but for a center of mission in the heart of the city, a community center where the church could work hand-in-hand with other faith-based non-profit ministries to change lives in the city of Des Moines. This is our call as a church as well.



This is what the Shining the Light Together campaign is all about. This is an opportunity for our entire church to unify around Jesus' vision for His church in Matthew 5 to shine our light in a dark world and impact lives for eternity! What other mission can offer that?! Ultimately, this campaign is not about a building, a church, or finances. Growing Deep and Wide

In 2021, we concluded a campaign called Building to a Hope Beyond which made it possible for us to move into our current facility at 2500 University Ave. with minimal debt. This space has not only allowed Hope Des Moines and Elim Christian Fellowship to join together as Hope+Elim, but made it possible for us to reach out to thousands of people in our city through ministries, events, programs, and outreach that we wouldn't have been able to without the capacity.

In the past three years, God has truly made us a 24/7 center of mission with all five levels filled with ministry!

A Center of Mission

In addition to a growing, thriving congregation, Hope+Elim is the home to four local mission partner organizations building the kingdom here in Des Moines. Our building partners have both dedicated space for offices and ministry, as well as shared space with our church for community events. The impact of these organizations extends well beyond our walls to families, schools, and communities across the state.











Change Course is a career development program that provides training in highly sought-after skills along with leadership and personal development, to give people in Des Moines a way to stop living paycheck to paycheck and launch a career.



Fellowship of Christian Athletes is an interdenominational Christian sports ministry to see the world impacted for Jesus Christ through the influence of coaches and athletes.



Genesis Youth Foundation is dedicated to helping refugee families level the playing field through athletic play, the arts and academic enrichment.



Joshua Christian Academy JCA's mission is to build a Christ-centered academic foundation within the hearts and minds of urban children, equipping them and their families to serve God and others to their fullest potential through outstanding biblical education.

Strategic Priorities

Over the past few years, four strategic priorities have emerged as areas of focus we believe is calling us to in the years ahead. This campaign will not only allow us to continue the great ministry taking place, but expand our ability to reach more people with the light of Jesus. Based on Lutheran Church of Hope's overall **10 for 10 vision** for 2020-2030, we believe God is calling us to:

SERVE the City

Develop a deeper and more consistent neighborhood presence through listening, hosting, service, and education on current needs in the city, while increasing collaboration with mission partners and other local churches to become a lighthouse in Des Moines.

EXPAND Worship Opportunities

Develop brand new expressions of multi-cultural worship focusing on unreached groups, demographics and cultures while continuing to refine and innovate within current expressions.

BUILD Disciples

Align, unify, and expand adult and young adult discipleship opportunities around a "discipleship pathway" with clear next steps to grow Christ-centered disciples.

REACH Next Generations

Unapologetically compete for the hearts of new generations through listening, serving, investing in schools, and partnership with existing ministries to reach children, students, colleges, and young adults.



Shining Brighter!

We believe God is calling us to care for our physical *lighthouse*, as well as make it even more effective at shining the light of Jesus Christ.



At the 2023 annual meeting of Lutheran Church of Hope, the congregation voted to approve the giving campaign and project costs up to \$2,250,000, with any funds given above that amount to go towards debt reduction. Current debt sits at \$918,000, which is split between a bank loan and an internal loan from Lutheran Church of Hope. Given our lower amount of current debt, we are now able to pursue these important capital improvements.

The areas of financial focus for the campaign will be:

- Installation of central air conditioning on levels 3-5 (Mezzanine also) to allow year-round programing and use by our building partners and church ministries. Currently the space is not ideal for ministry four months out of the year due to heat. This upgrade is about fully utilizing the space God has given us for ministry.
- Kitchen upgrades for equipment to support over 500 meals being prepared for weekly ministry and hundreds more for community events. Gathering around meals was a key aspect to Jesus' ministry and in turn has become a unifying and strategic aspect of our ministry at Hope+Elim to bring all people together in community. The current kitchen is under-resourced and ill-equipped for large-scale, quality, modern food ministry.
- The purchase of two large vehicles/ vans/buses to support the growth of our transportation ministry which currently serves up to 50 individuals weekly with the potential

to expand to many more group or individual pick-up options. Our outreach is limited by not having enough vehicles with the capacity and quality to transport guests week with excellent hospitality.

- Production upgrades for sound, lighting, and video equipment to modernize the worship center and replace other decades-old equipment. Our current projector has reached the end of its projected life-span with a washout image, our lighting is limited for larger worship services and events, and our current sound equipment is not equipped for our vision of a gospel choir or any other expansion into multi-cultural worship expressions.
- Large-scale facility maintenance including boiler, elevator, and plumbing maintenance. Older equipment requires more expensive parts, and some maintenance has been deferred for years under the previous owners of our facility.

The Shining the Light Together campaign is an opportunity for giving above and beyond regular tithes and offerings to make these capital investments in the future of our church and the kingdom. This will be a two-year campaign where we'll have the opportunity to give up front gifts or pledges for gifts to be given January 2024 — December 2025. Gifts to the campaign will be used at the discretion of Hope+Elim church leadership towards the above projects in collaboration with Lutheran Church of Hope's Senior Leadership team and church council. Rather than giving to a specific capital project, the campaign is an opportunity to invest in the overall vision of God's lighthouse.

The three giving goals, providing prayer targets for the congregation will be:

Victory Goal	\$1,000,000.00
Dream Goal	\$1,500,000.00
Miracle Goal	\$2,500.000.00



Campaign Goals

Larger than meeting financial goals, our ultimate goal is the **further discipleship of Hope+Elim** in our understanding of Biblical stewardship. With the projected general fund deficit of Hope+Elim (\$300,000.00 for the current fiscal year), we see the campaign as an opportunity to directly impact the joy-filled, generous giving of the congregation as well. Regardless of capital improvements, if we are able to grow in our Biblical understanding and application of God's Word to stewardship of our time, talent, and treasure, the campaign will be a success.

To this end, our goals for the campaign will be to:

1. GATHER | Weekly Worship

Why? **Inspiration:** Worship is spiritual exercise for the body of Christ and a time for intimacy with God, healing for the hurt, sanctuary from chaos, water for dry souls, and spiritual food for the soul; a Holy Spirit hangout, hospital for sinners, a place of renewal, and holy ground.

2. GROW | Develop a Daily Prayer Routine

- *Why?* **Conversation:** The most important voice you could hear in your life is that of God. Take time to develop more effective communication patterns and a deeper bond between you and God.
- *How?* Make good use of the prayer guide available in your campaign materials or online at hope-elim.org/shine.
 - **5@5** Commit to pray daily for 5 minutes (or more!) at 5:00 pm each day during the campaign wherever you are and ask God to guide your giving.
 - Unity Prayer Walk Join us on Sunday, Nov. 12, 11:15 am as we surround our current facility in prayer.
 - 24 Hour Prayer Join us on Saturday, Nov. 18, 10:00 am Sunday, Nov.19, 10:00 am. Sign up for one of many 30 minute prayer shifts on or offsite to pray for Commitment Sunday. This will begin with a prayer gathering on Saturday, Nov. 18, 10:00 am – 12:00 pm. Sign up at hope-elim.org/shine.

Dive into the Bible

- *Why?* **Revelation:** Experience life-changing freedom as you immerse yourself in the living Word of God.
- *How?* Continue to **meet regularly** with your Life Group to dive deeper into God's Word.

3. GIVE | Discover the Joy of Cheerful Giving

Why? Liberation: Find freedom in guilt-free, pressure-free giving; not under compulsion, but cheerfully, generously, and freely!

How? Understand that everything we have belongs to God:

- Wait for God to answer.
- Give as a matter of God's revelation, not human reason.
- Give with a sense of God's timing for the eternal impact of our gifts.

Discover the Joy of Cheerful Giving





Shining the Light Together provides every person in the Hope+Elim family with a great opportunity to discover the joy and freedom of financial giving God's way! It's not complicated. In order to discover what it really means to be a "cheerful giver," we need to seek God's revelation, not human reason.

Try these steps:

Step One | Pray

Ask God this question: "Lord, what do you want to do through me to accomplish your will for Hope+Elim?"

"Keep on asking, and you will be given what you ask for. Keep on looking, and you will find. Keep on knocking, and the door will be opened." *Matthew* 7:7

Step Two | Listen to God

Keep asking until you "hear" God's answer. If you don't get anything – in other words, if you don't get a pretty strong indication in your heart, soul or mind as you pray each day throughout this campaign – then quiet your life until you can. Be still. Listen to God, not people. God will write a number on your heart, soul or mind.

Step Three | Take a Leap of Faith

Trust God enough to do whatever he calls you to do, believing that he will provide the means to make it happen (2 Corinthians 9:6-11). Now you're giving as a matter of faith – and thus, experiencing the joy and freedom of Bible- based giving without anyone telling you, other than God, what to give! Enjoy the feeling!
